



Gärtner's "Game and Sport"

- Premium-quality mixture with tested, high-quality lawn grasses. Ideal for the grassing of lawns that are subject to heavy-duty use.
- Helps dense lawn formation, is low maintenance, extremely robust, resistant to dry conditions and regenerates well.

Instructions for sowing and care:

- Before sowing the seedbed should be prepared thoroughly. To do this, loosen the soil by digging the soil to a depth of 20 – 30 cm and at the same time removing all the weeds and other obtrusive materials. By spreading between approx. 240 l (good soil) and 360 l (poor soil) of potting soil or planting soil per 100 m² the soil will be loosened in the long term and the air and water circulation will be improved, thus facilitating the germination of the seeds. At the same time, the initial dose for the young plants should be 5 kg of Gärtner's mineral and organic lawn fertiliser per 100 m² for complete supply of the most important nutrients. Work the spread product evenly up to 15 cm into the soil, and at the same time ensure that the topsoil is fine. It is important that the soil is then rolled or trodden down carefully to ensure reconsolidation of the seedbed and a uniform, even surface.
- **Important: mix the seeds thoroughly before sowing!**
- Before sowing, just rake the compacted soil lightly. Spread the mixed seed evenly. For a uniformly thick lawn always sow in two working steps, both lengthwise and crosswise. Mixing the seed with the same amount of dry sand is a tried and tested way of improving dosing and facilitating spreading. Then roll or tread down the area that has been sown.
- Water regularly and thoroughly with a fine jet in the mornings and evenings. The first step should be to cut the grass from approx. 8 cm down to approx. 3 cm. Then mow regularly, at least once a week. To maintain the nutrient supply, apply 30 g m² of Gärtner's lawn fertiliser with long-term effect once or twice more before the end of September.
- Application should depend on the rate of growth and frequency of mowing.
