



## Gärtner's blue fertiliser 8 + 8 + 8

- nitrogen for targeted and lasting plant growth
- balanced phosphate content for radiant blossoms and strong fruit growth
- potash for a high-quality harvest and healthy plant tissue
- plant-friendly potassium sulphate, which is especially beneficial to berries and vegetables

### Required amounts for vegetables:

## Gärtner's blue fertiliser 8 + 8 + 8

### Required amounts for flowers, perennials, ornamental shrubs:

Flowers, perennials, ornamental shrubs	Spring fertilisation, March	Summer fertilisation, second half of June	Summer fertilisation, end of July/beginning of August
Perennials – up to 50 cm in height	70	-	-
Perennials – more than 50 cm in height	70	40	-
Summer flowers: e.g. ageratum, lobelias, salvia, zinnias etc.	-	50	40
Roses	100	50	40
Shrubs – slow growing	90	-	-
Shrubs – fast growing	100	80	-

### Required amounts for fruit:

Fruit	1st fertilisation g/m <sup>2</sup>	2nd fertilisation g/m <sup>2</sup>	3rd fertilisation g/m <sup>2</sup>
Pome and stone fruit	early spring 60	after flowering 30	after the June fruit drop 30
Berry bushes	early spring 80	after flowering 40	-
Strawberries (new plants)	before planting 50	6 weeks later 40	-
Strawberries (ready for harvesting)	early spring 30	after the harvest 50	in August 40

### Tips:

- After spreading, work gently into the soil.
- Has a faster effect if the fertiliser in the ground is dissolved by precipitation or watering.
- When planting for the first time do not pour fertiliser into the planting hole, because direct contact with the roots should be avoided.

### Dosage of Gärtner's blue fertiliser:

- 1 handful approx. 60 g
- 1 tablespoon approx. 25 g
