



## Gärtner's blue fertiliser 12 + 6 + 15 + 2

- contains all the main and important trace nutrients in mineralised form
- nitrogen for targeted and lasting plant growth
- balanced phosphate content for radiant flowers and strong fruit growth
- potash for a high-quality harvest and healthy plant tissue
- plant-friendly potassium sulphate, which is especially beneficial to berries and vegetables
- magnesium for perfect chlorophyll formation
- trace nutrients for the prevention of deficiency signs

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### Required amounts for flowers, perennials, ornamental shrubs:

Flowers, perennials, ornamental shrubs	Spring fertilisation, March	Summer fertilisation, second half of June	Summer fertilisation, end of July/beginning of August
Perennials – up to 50 cm in height	50	-	-
Perennials – more than 50 cm in height	50	30	-
Summer flowers: e.g. ageratum, lobelias, salvia, zinnias etc.	-	50	50
Roses	70	30	30
Shrubs – slow growing	60	-	-
Shrubs – fast growing	80	60	-

### Required amounts for fruit:

Fruit	1st fertilisation g/m <sup>2</sup>	2nd fertilisation g/m <sup>2</sup>	3rd fertilisation g/m <sup>2</sup>
Pome and stone fruit	early spring 40	after flowering 20	after the June fruit drop 20
Berry bushes	early spring 50	after flowering 30	-
Strawberries (new plants)	before planting 30	6 weeks after 30	-
Strawberries (ready for harvesting)	early spring 30	after the harvest 50	in August 30

### Tips:

- After spreading, work gently into the soil.
- Works faster if the fertiliser is dissolved in the soil by precipitation or watering.
- When planting for the first time do not pour fertiliser into the planting hole because direct contact with the roots should be avoided.

### Dosage of Gärtner's blue fertiliser:

- 1 handful approx. 90 g
- 1 tablespoon approx. 25 g
