



Gärtner's rose fertiliser

- optimum plant food for roses, shrubs and flowering ornamental plants
- balanced nutrient ratio ensures strong and healthy plants
- increases resistance to mildew, pests and adverse environmental influences
- ensures rich, colourful and lavish flowers
- spread evenly around the plants and work gently into the soil
- after fertilising, spray and water plants
- do not fertilise the roses from August onwards

Required quantities:

- 1st dose: 40 – 50 g/m² after cutting the roses in spring at the beginning of budding
- 2nd dose: 40 – 50 g/m² approx. 3 weeks after the beginning of flowering until the middle of July

Application period:

Jan	Feb	March	April	May	June	July	August	Sept	Oct	Nov	Dec

Tip:

- When replanting, mix the planting soil at a ratio of 2 parts topsoil to 1 part growing medium (e.g. plant humus), put the plants into the soil, press the soil around the plants and water sufficiently.

Dosage of Gärtner's rose fertiliser:

- 1 handful approx. 40 g
- 1 tablespoon approx. 15 g
